### **Adoration**

"The doctor put the baby in Juana's arms. "He will get well now," he said. "I have won the fight." And Juana looked at him with <u>adoration</u>."

Deep love and respect.

# **Baptize**

"He wondered what the pearl would be worth. And he wondered whether he had <u>baptized</u> Kino's baby, or married him for that matter."

A ceremonial immersion in water as an initiatory rite or sacrament of the Christian church.

### **Benediction**

"Kino," he said softly, "thou art named after a great manand a great Father of the Church." He made it sound like a benediction." The utterance or bestowing of a blessing, especially at the end of a religious service.

### **Brood**

"It is nothing," Kino said, but his eyes and his voice were hard and cold and a brooding hate was growing in him."

Think deeply about something that makes one unhappy.

#### Caress

"The neighbours showed one another with their thumbs how big the pearl was, and they made little <u>caressing</u> gestures to show how lovely it was."

Touch or stroke gently or lovingly.

#### Colonial

"A town is a thing like a <u>colonial</u> animal. A town has a nervous system and a head and shoulders and feet."

Relating to or characteristic of a colony or colonies.

### Conceal

"He wrapped the pearl in the rag, then... dug a little hole with his fingers in the dirt floor, and he put the pearl in the hole and covered it up and <u>concealed</u> the place."

Keep (something) secret; prevent from being known or noticed.

#### Curt

"The baby is nearly well now," he said <u>curtly</u>. The doctor smiled, but his eyes in their little lymph-lined hammocks did not smile."

Rudely brief.

# **Despair**

"But there was a price below which they dared not go, for it had happened that a fisherman in <u>despair</u> had given his pearls to the church."

The complete loss or absence of hope.

## **Disparage**

"For it is said that humans are never satisfied, that you give them one thing and they want something more. And this is said in <u>disparagement</u>,"

To express scornfully one's low opinion of.

### **Dissemble**

"Everyone knew why the doctor had come. He was not good at <u>dissembling</u> and he was very well understood."

Conceal one's true motives, feelings, or beliefs.

# Fringe

"Juana stood up from the fire and backed away as he entered, and she covered the baby's face with the <u>fringe</u> of her shawl."

The line or relatively narrow space that marks the outer limit of something.

## **Judicious**

"And when it was made plain who Kino was, the doctor grew stern and <u>judicious</u> at the same time. "He is a client of mine," the doctor said."

Having or showing good judgment and restraint especially in conduct or speech.

#### Lantern

"Standing in the door, he saw two men approach; and one of them carried a <u>lantern</u> which lighted the ground and the legs of the men."

A device that provides light and that usually has a glass covering and can be carried by a handle.

#### Lucent

"All of these things Kino saw in the <u>lucent</u> pearl and he said: "We will have new clothes."

Glowing with or giving off light.

#### Lust

"Every man suddenly became related to Kino's pearl, and Kino's pearl went into the dreams, the speculations, the schemes,... the <u>lusts</u>, the hungers, of everyone,"

A passionate desire for something.

### Marvel

"Now the neighbours knew they had witnessed a great marvel."

Something extraordinary or surprising.

# **Prophecy**

"But Kino's face shone with <u>prophecy</u>. "My son will read and open the books, and my son will write and will know writing."

A prediction.

### Residue

"The essence of pearl mixed with essence of men and a curious dark <u>residue</u> was precipitated."

A small amount of something that remains after the main part has gone or been taken or used.

### Scowl

"His dark eyes <u>scowled</u> into the little fire, and for the first time he knew that his knife was still in his hands, and he raised... it and saw a little line of blood on the steel."

An angry or bad-tempered expression.

## **Semblance**

"For there were not many buyers really - there was only one, and he kept these agents in separate offices to give a semblance of competition."

The outward appearance of something, especially when the reality is different.

# Spasm

"The <u>spasm</u> of the stomach muscles began, and the baby was very sick."

A sudden involuntary muscular contraction or convulsive movement.

# **Subjugation**

"Kino stood in the door, filling it, and hatred raged and flamed in back of his eyes, and fear too, for the hundreds of years of <u>subjugation</u> were cut deep in him." The action of bringing someone or something under domination or control.

# **Transfigure**

"If these things came to pass, they would recount how Kino looked and what he said and how his eyes shone, and they would say: "He was a man <u>transfigured</u>."

To change in form, appearance, or use.
