Abortion- The deliberate termination of a human pregnancy. Alms- Money or food given to poor people. Appraise- Assess the value or quality of. Avarice- Extreme greed for wealth or material gain. Beggar- A person, typically a homeless one, who lives by asking for money or food. Despise- To dislike (something or someone) very much. Discontent- Not pleased or satisfied. Feint- Make a deceptive or distracting movement, especially during a fight. Frantic- Wild or distraught with fear, anxiety, or other emotion. Indigene- An indigenous person. Indigent- Poor; needy. Interval- A period of time between events. Mutter- Say something in a low or barely audible voice, especially in dissatisfaction or irritation. Plaintive- Expressing suffering or sadness. Plaza- A public square, marketplace, or similar open space in a built-up area. Poverty- The state of being extremely poor. Puncture- A small hole in something such as the skin, caused by a sharp object. Reassure- Say or do something to remove the doubts or fears of (someone). Scandal- An action or event regarded as morally or legally wrong and causing general public outrage. Shawl- A piece of fabric worn by women over the shoulders or head or wrapped around a baby. Strenuous- Requiring or showing great energy and effort. Suppliant- Making or expressing a plea, especially to someone in power or authority. Timid- Showing a lack of courage or confidence; easily frightened.
